- The influence of subsidizing pulses in India's Public Distribution System (PDS) on household consumption and nutrition is evaluated in the study by Chakrabarti, Kishore, and Roy. Utilizing NSSO CES data and Difference-in-Differences (DID) analysis, they discover that household consumption of pulses and overall protein intake are somewhat increased by subsidized pulses. Still, this rise does not greatly increase overall consumption; rather, it primarily replaces market purchases. The study emphasizes that rather than serving as a direct nutritional intervention, the subsidy functions as an economic transfer. The difficulty to identify PDS pulse buyers and the interval between pre- and post-treatment data are among the limitations. The results highlight the necessity of long-term plans, such as raising local pulse production, to guarantee accessible and reasonably priced food. Although the subsidy helps to somewhat close the gap between the

recommended and actual intake amounts, concerns are raised over its.

- The study by Correa et al. looks at how Indian and Canadian teenagers see healthy eating, and it finds that they have similar ideas about homemade and nutrient-dense foods. Adolescents in rural India place a premium on food free of contaminants, while opinions on the use of meat and its effects on nutrition differ. Improved energy and disease prevention are two advantages of eating healthily in all contexts; peer pressure and food accessibility are two obstacles. Girls from Canada and Indian cities confront extra difficulties like lack of parental supervision and academic stress. The study identifies options for enhancing teenage dietary habits in a variety of circumstances and offers focused treatments that include culturally appropriate nutrition education, stress management techniques, parental participation, food safety laws, and limitations on the marketing of unhealthy foods.
- In South India, Swaminathan and Thomas look into children's views on eating well, what they think is healthy and unhealthy, and the effects of eating poorly on one's health. Based on baseline data from a three-year longitudinal study involving 307 school-age children, they investigate eating behaviors, attitudes toward healthful eating, and relationships with mother education levels and socioeconomic position. The results show that opinions about eating healthily vary depending on factors like age, gender, maternal education, and family history of chronic illness. There is a need for coordinated efforts to convert knowledge into behavior change because dietary choices do not alter even in the face of knowledge regarding health benefits and nutritious foods. The significance of focused interventions to support schoolchildren in South India's adoption of healthy eating practices is highlighted by this study.
- The review by Chellaiyan et al. explores baby feeding patterns in India, highlighting the country's predominance of plant-based complementary foods and the insufficiency of animal foods in fulfilling micronutrient needs. They draw attention to the differences in food fortification practices between rich and poor nations and talk about long-term solutions including adding vital micronutrients to milk, vegetable oils, wheat flour, and multigrain

flour. The authors highlight the vital role that the best eating practices for infants and young children play in ensuring their survival, and they underline the necessity of moms and families taking an active role in encouraging healthy feeding practices. In order to effectively support mothers in age-appropriate feeding habits and fight for comprehensive nutritional policies targeting infants and young children, they emphasize the significance of bridging gaps in the skills and knowledge of healthcare providers.

- Ali, Alam, and Ali explore how consumer buying habits for wellness and health food products are evolving in India, emphasizing the growing understanding of the role that food plays in promoting health and preventing disease. They stress the huge market potential that India offers for these kinds of goods, given the notable increase that has been seen there over time. The competitive landscape with an average HHI of 0.19 is shown by the authors' analysis of market competitiveness using the Herfindahl-Hirschman Index (HHI). They do point out, nevertheless, that the market structure for various kinds, categories, prime positioning, and routes of distribution for food items related to health and wellness varies. This study helps players analyze market trends and adjust their plans by offering insightful information about the dynamics of the Indian health and wellness food market.
- The study by Barrett et al. investigates the connection between young children's dietary quality and their access to wholesome food outlets at home and at school. They discover that improved diet quality is linked to increased access to all kinds of food outlets, with a larger benefit seen for healthy outlets. The authors propose that local governments can contribute to the expansion of healthy retail options available to families with young children. The study emphasizes how crucial the food environment is in influencing kids' eating patterns and how more research is required to back up intervention tactics. Their findings provide insightful information for policymakers and health professionals, highlighting the need of encouraging access to healthy food outlets to improve the dietary quality of young children.
- The association between perceived availability of healthy foods in neighborhoods and geographic metrics of retail food outlets is investigated by Barnes et al. The significance of taking into account both presence and distance metrics when evaluating the food environment is highlighted by their finding that the availability of supermarkets within a given distance is a major predictor of perceived healthy food options. The results of the study indicate that perception-based and geographic measures have different connections, indicating that they are two different constructs.
- The use of verified GIS-based metrics is one of the study's strengths; limitations include sample demographics and survey response rate. The results highlight the intricate nature of the food environment and provide guidance to researchers and policymakers in creating efficient policies and programs that support community access to healthy food.
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- In order to investigate regulatory interventions aimed at the food environment, Shill et al. conducted in-depth interviews with senior members from Australian state/territory governments, statutory authorities, and non-government organizations. Interventions like controlling the promotion of unhealthy food, reducing the number of fast food outlets, changing prices, and improving product labeling were frequently recommended by participants. Support did, however, differ throughout interventions, with the measures pertaining to food

marketing and services garnering the greatest support. The necessity of cooperative methods, industry influence, regulatory issues, and financial disincentives were among the major themes. Policies promoting healthy food service were among the interventions that received support; nevertheless, due to opposition from the business sector and requests for deregulation, obstacles still stand in the way of initiatives like marketing limitations and fiscal interventions.

- Hubley carried out research on the state of the food environment in rural Maine, concentrating on the presence of food deserts and the availability of nutritious food options. The research team assessed the county's SNAP outlets using the Nutrition Environment Measure Survey (NEMS) program as a model, selecting 50 establishments for investigation. According to the standard "food desert" paradigm, the study found that there was greater spatial access to healthy food choices than anticipated. This suggests that low-income consumers can reasonably visit supermarkets. This contradicts the oversimplified description of rural regions and is consistent with earlier studies. The SNAP-Ed program of the USDA and the Maine Department of Education provided funding for the project

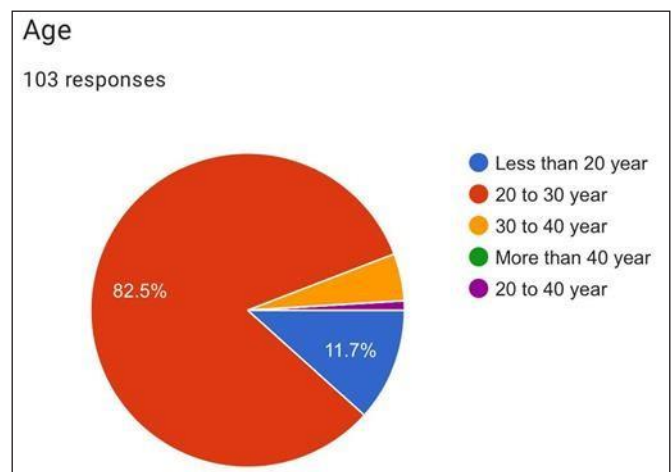

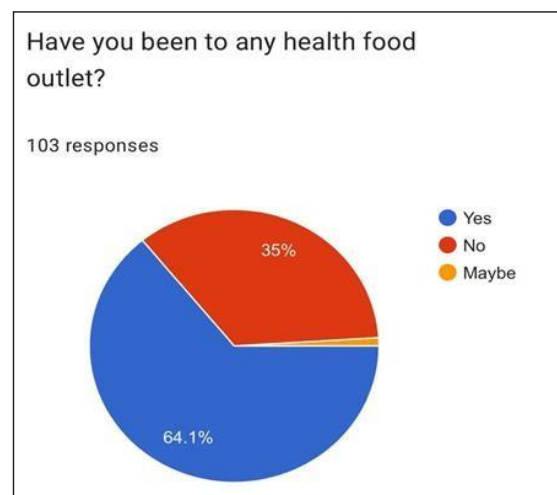
Analyzing the Data Based on Responds of Questionnaire

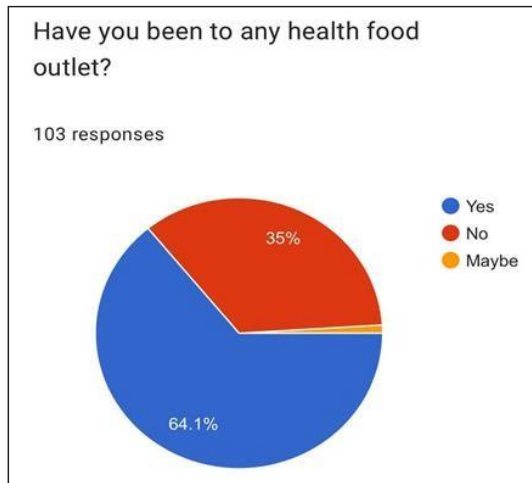
People Have Been to Any Healthy Food Outlet



Of the surveyed population, 64.1% have visited a health food outlet, indicating a significant inclination towards

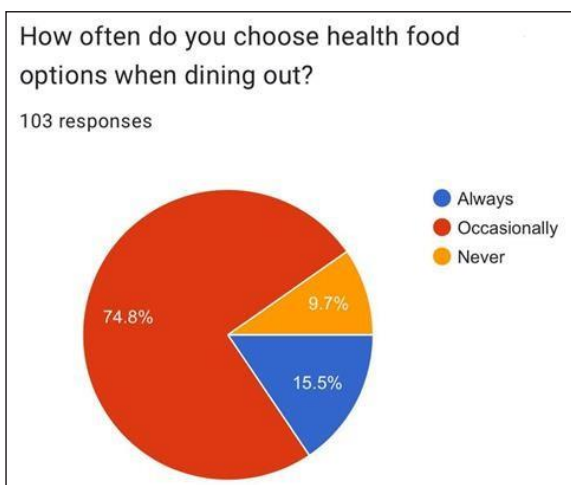
healthy eating choices. Conversely, 35% have yet to explore such establishments, while a minority remain undecided.

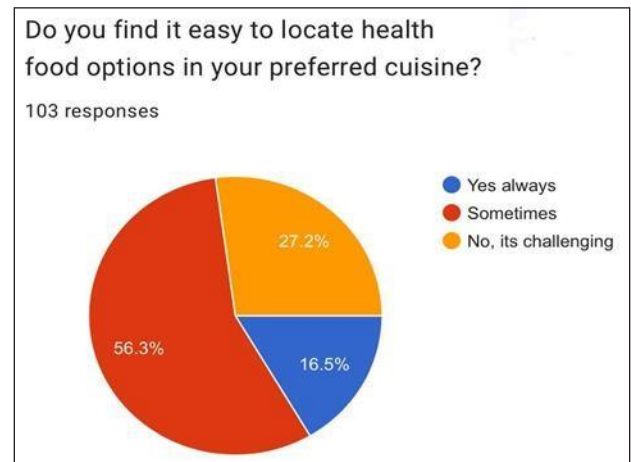
How Often Do People Choose Health Food Options When Dining Out



Approximately 74.5% of individuals are occasionally opting for health food outlet choices when dining out, reflecting a growing trend towards healthier eating habits.

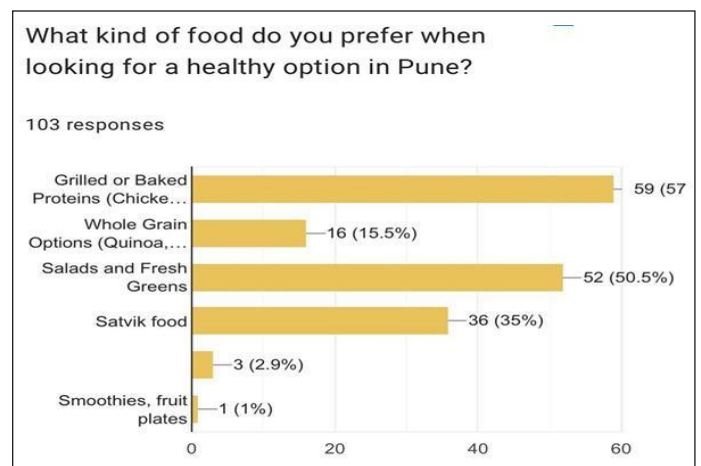

Health Food Options in Your Preferred Cuisine



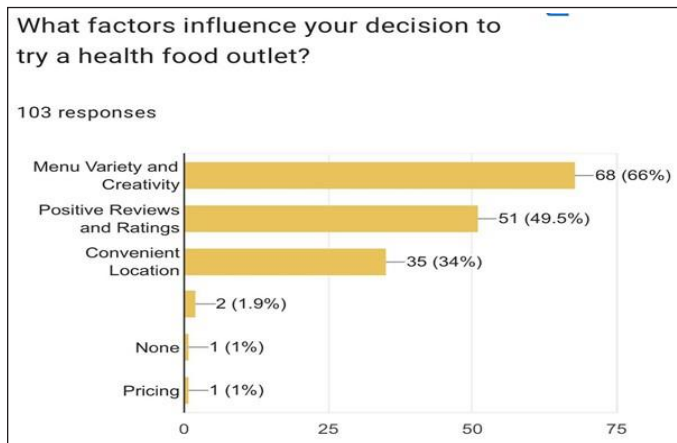
56.3% occasionally find health food options, 16.5% always do, while 27.2% find it challenging to locate them within their preferred cuisine.

Kind of Food People Prefer When Looking for a Healthy Option in Pune



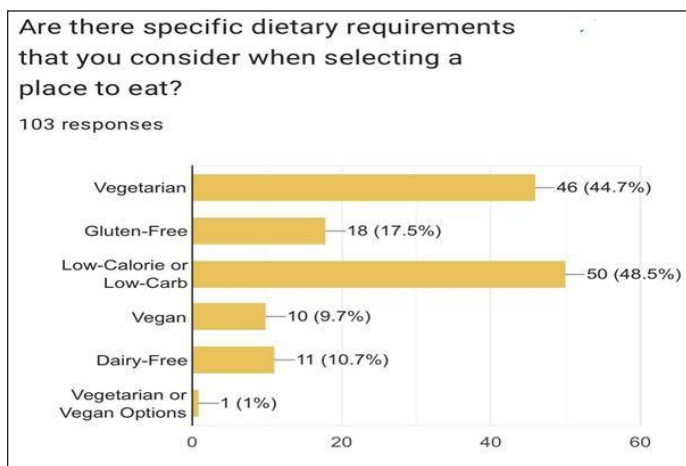

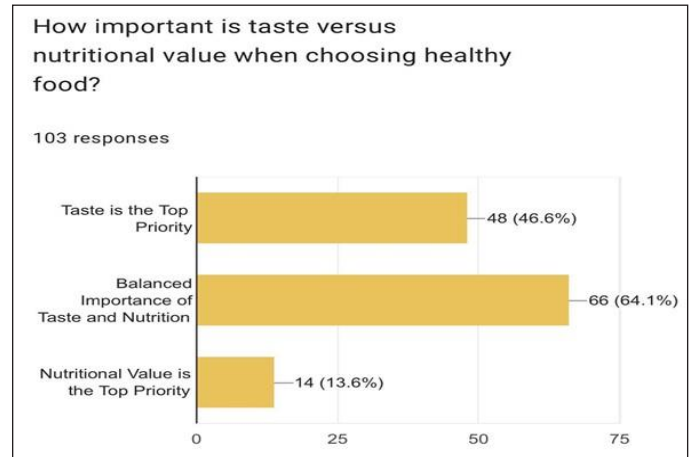
Specific Dietary Requirements that People Consider when Selecting A Place to Eat

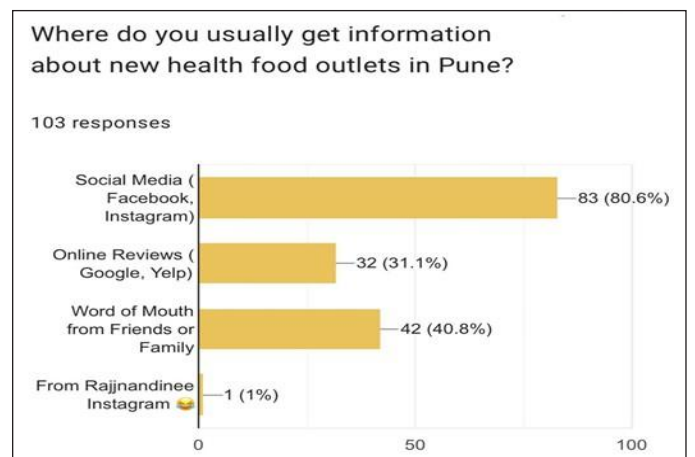
dairy-free alternatives, while a smaller 1% exclusively choose vegan options.

Importance of Taste Versus Nutritional Value when Choosing Healthy Food



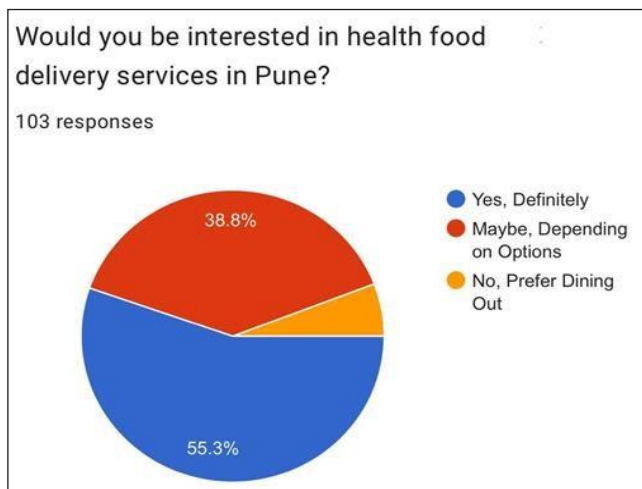

Platforms Providing Information about New Health Food Outlets in Pune



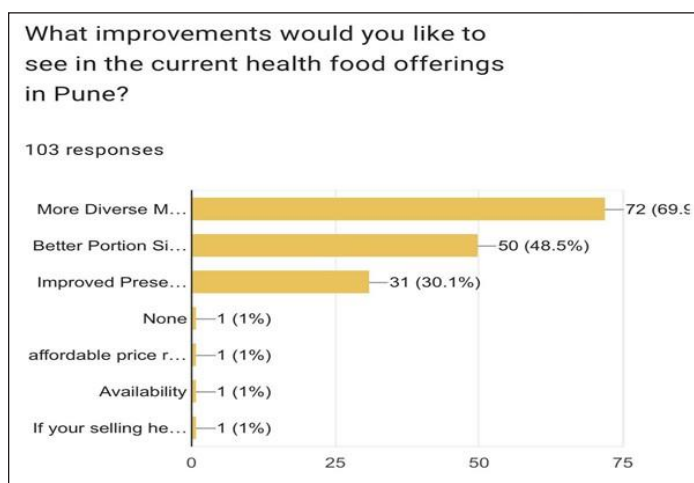

A minority, comprising 1% each, express the need for affordability and availability improvements, reflecting diverse considerations for enhancing the current health food offerings in the city.

FINDINGS

- Entrepreneurs can avail the social media platforms, billboards, hoardings to advertise their units to reach out to people in large to spread their presence in the market.
- Make available the delivery option without compromising with the quality, taste and nutritional value of the health food.
- Take advantage of synergies and improve value proposition, look into collaboration and partnership options with companies, suppliers, and organizations that complement each other also establish partnerships with local farmers markets and organic producers to source fresh produce.
